Eagle Project



For his Eagle Scout project, Connor designed, constructed, and installed a large storage box at Iron Horse Soccer Fields for use by the Simsbury Soccer Club TOPSoccer program, which gives physically and mentally challenged children the opportunity to participate in youth soccer. This box was created so that soccer equipment (balls, corner flags, cones, etc.) can be stored in a weatherproof location. The cost of the project was approximately \$350 dollars and paid for by the Simsbury Soccer Club. The storage box was constructed in Connor's workshop and later transported to Iron Horse for installation.
